2023 Parade Policies, Rules and Guidelines Application, Fees and Identification

The Parade will be held on Saturday, June 18, 2023 @ 10:00 a.m.

Applications will be accepted through June 3, 2023, or until the Parade is full. We encourage early applications - those received early receive first consideration and an opportunity for an earlier slot in the lineup.

A separate application must be submitted for each entry in the parade. Example: A school that enters their baton, twirlers, drum major and color guard must submit a separate application for each. If it is to be considered as one entry, submit one application only.

If an organization has more than one entry, please list on one of your applications, the order in which you wish for them to appear.

IMPORTANT All vehicle drivers must have personal liability insurance and submit a copy of their Proof of Insurance with their application. You will not be able to be in the parade if you do not provide this information.

The 2023 Juneteenth Committee must approve any variance from the parade application before the parade. Failure to get approval for changes may subject an entry, or any of its participants, to exclusion from the parade. Each entry is solely responsible for the safety of their participants.

An executed Indemnity Form must be provided for your entry's participants before the parade. Failure to provide an



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executed Indemnity Forms may subject your entry, or any of its participants, to exclusion from the parade.

NO CHARGE FOR THE FOLLOWING ORGANIZATIONS: Fire Department, EMS Vehicles, Marching Bands, and Elected Officials.

The fee must be submitted with a signed application, proof of insurance, and Identification to the 2023 Juneteenth Committee, P.O. Box 65142, Lubbock, Texas 79464, **no later than June 3, 2023.**

If you have a Returned Check - You will be charged a \$30 returned check fee and it, along with the parade entry fee, will be due within 1 week of the notification of the returned check in a Cashier's Check or Money Order.

Banner, Signs, and Entry Number

A banner or sign must be placed on both sides of the entries in order to be seen from both sides of the street. The banner or sign must state the name of your organization and identify your entry.

Each entry will receive an entry number, Saturday, June 18, 2023, upon arrival.

Position Numbers will be assigned, and the Parade Line-Up Coordinator will place the floats and other entries in the order they will proceed for the parade.

ALL PARADE ENTRIES MUST BE FULLY & APPROPRIATELY DECORATED OR THE ENTRY WILL BE SUBJECT TO EXCLUSION FROM THE PARADE WITH NO REIMBURSEMENT/REFUND.

Use of ingenuity and creativity in the design and execution of an entry is encouraged and favored for judging criteria.



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Handouts or Giveaways

Parade participants distributing handouts and giveaways (candy, novelties, coupons, etc...) should assign this task to two escorts walking along either side of the entry.

Parade Performances

Any performance along the parade route must be a moving/marching routine.

TAHC Statutory Authority

Owners of animals participating in the parade must provide a certificate of Veterinary Inspection or Health Certificate "CVI". Coggins tests are required within the last 12 months, prior to entry. Documents must be available for inspection if the Health Department makes a request the day of the parade. For more information go to <http://www.tahc.state.tx.us>.

Support Vehicles

Marching units and walking entries are permitted to have one support vehicle.

Motorized entries (floats, cars, etc.) will not be permitted to have a support vehicle. A float and a tow vehicle comprise one unit. You must describe your vehicle on the entry application form to be eligible to have a support vehicle in the parade.

Safety Rules

No child under eight years of age will be allowed to walk in the parade. They may ride on floats, vehicles, or bicycles under adult supervision.

At no time shall anyone on the float attempt to step off of the float while the float is in motion, this applies to all entries.

An on-board fire extinguisher is highly recommended and mandatory if portable generators are used.

Bike riders must adhere to state and local laws regarding helmets.

Drivers of floats and vehicles must maintain a **two car lengths distance** between each entry.



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Consumption of alcohol by participants during staging or on the parade route is strictly prohibited.

The Lubbock Police Department will be notified of any suspected intoxication or violation of the rules and the entry will be removed from the parade.

All entries are required to be ready to step-off at the appropriate time and any entry not prepared will forfeit their opportunity and entry fee, regardless of the reason.

All floats shall have a skirt to cover the wheels within the bounds of safety.

No super structure may exceed 14 feet from street level and must be wired or otherwise secured. It must be able to go under utility wires along the parade route.

All entries will stay in their assigned places until instructed by the Parade Coordinator.

Speed of the entries in the parade and control of traffic will be under the direction of the Lubbock Police Department. Parade Committee members will be along the route to offer assistance.

Animals participating in the parade must be harnessed or leashed. Owners must provide insurance and proof of liability for animals with their application and must have proof available on the day of the event.

To avoid the possibility of injury to participants and attendants, Participants **must not** throw candy or other items from any float or vehicle in the parade. *This policy is strictly enforced.* Persons walking next to the barricade line may distribute candy and other items. Nothing may be handed out in the path of your entry - only on the sides of your entry (*Entries that refuse to cooperate will be banned from future events*)

Judging and Voting of Entries

We encourage you to invest in a quality entry. Remember, parade floats and entries are excellent promotional/advertising opportunities for your organization. The winners will be announced on Saturday, June 17, 2023 during the Saturday stage.

1st, 2nd, and 3rd Trophies are given for the People's Choice Award.
